It was reported and alleged vide complaint dated 09.10.2013 and corroborated by inquiry report dated 12.10.2013 that the aforementioned student habitually resort to sexual abuse of the relatively junior roommates, keeps pornographic films in his mobile set and in the late hours of the night allegedly had induced the junior students of the Allama Iqbal Hall specially his roommates to watch such films and in the event of refusal they were threatened of dire consequences. It was further reported and alleged that aforementioned student allegedly invites undesirable elements to his room from outside and indulge in excessive smoking causing inconvenience to the roommates. Aforementioned student in past allegedly was involved ransacking University property. A mobile set loaded with pornographic clips and a packet of the cigarette in the course of search was recovered from his possession. It was also reported vide application R.No.6949/Proc. dated 10.10.2013 that student under reference threatened employees of the Hall who reported against him of dire consequence if disciplinary action was initiated against him.

In view of the above facts and circumstances it was prima-facie established that afore-noted student committed acts of gross misconduct and indiscipline as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (ii), (iv), (viii), (xii) and (xix) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 3768/Proc. dated 19.10.2013. The Charge Sheet was also issued to him LD.No.430/Proc. dated 01.02.2014. The reply of the charge sheet was received in this office R.No. 699/Proc. dated 03.02.2014 at 02:30 pm and was found not satisfactory, hence listed for hearing before the Discipline Committee. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.436 /Proc. dated 01.02.2014 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date, time and venue.

The aforementioned student accordingly appeared in person before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time. The Chairman of the Committee refreshing the memory of the charge sheeted student read over charges framed against him and thereafter he was required to explain his position. The student substantial confessed the alleged charges but denied the charge of forcing his roommate to watch the objectionable films loaded in his mobile. He was extremely regretfully of his alleged misconduct and also broke down before the Discipline Committee begging repeatedly pardon from the members ensuring simultaneously not to repeat same in future if exonerated.

Whereas in view of his incriminating statements the charges frame against the student were proved and therefore, he was found guilty of misconducts and indiscipline as provided Part-II, Rule-4 (ii), (iv), (viii), (xii) and (xix) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985 but the members of the Discipline Committee were convinced with his remorse and therefore, took the lenient view in the recommending penalty to be imposed on the student.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on **05.02.2014 (Wednesday) at 03:30 pm.** in the **Pro-Vice-Chancellor** Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) That the Office Memo LD.No.3768/Proc. dated 19.10.2013 placing Mohammad Suhail under suspension is revoked with immediate effect.
- (b) That he is hereby made N.R.S.C. with immediate effect for current academic session i.e. 2013-2014.
- (c) That the Principal of Sr. Sec. School (Boys) is requested to call the parent/guardian of the student in his Office and may advice him to maintain watch over his ward.
- (d) That the student under reference is required to furnish an undertaking in writing within a week from the service of the notice to keep good behaviour in future failing which *suo-moto* action may follow against him.

It was reported vide application R.No. 4005//Proc. dated 13.12.2013 that aforementioned student alongwith one Soban Khan S/o. Mr. Khursheed Ahmad Khan, Resident of Hasanpur Mohalla Fort East Distt. Amroha was caught red handed in the intervening night of 12/13.12.2013 at about 04:00 a.m. pasting and distributing pamphlet in S.S. Hall (North) by the patrolling Security Staff of the Proctor Office. It was further reported and alleged that on being searched in huge quantity of pamphlet from the possession of the aforementioned student and Soban Khan, an outsider was recovered. The contents of the pamphlet reportedly were extremely obnoxious, derogatory to the dignity and status of the persons indicated therein. The pamphlets under reference were also calculated to undermine the honour and reputation of a female student who recently lodged a complaint against a senior teacher of the University for outraging her modesty. The aforementioned student in the course of interrogation confessed that he along with Soban went to S.S. Hall (North), pasted and distributed objectionable pamphlets in the Hall and in the campus purportedly to disturb peace and harmony in and outside the campus.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, it was *prima-facie* made out that aforementioned student committed acts of indiscipline and misconduct under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii), (vi), (xv) & (xxvii) of AMU Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 4463/Proc. dated 14.12.2013. The Charge Sheet was also issued to him LD.No.429/Proc. dated 01.02.2014. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.439/Proc. dated 01.02.2014 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date, time and venue.

He accordingly appeared before the Discipline Committee. The Chairman of the Committee refreshing his memory read over the charges and asked him to defend himself. The student narrated the sequence of incident and submitted that he fell prey to his own innocence and denied his hands in gloves with Soban who in fact pasted the pamphlet. He was cross examined by putting the questions with a view to elicit the name of the person who might have hired him for the alleged handy work but he expressed his absolute ignorance this to effect.

In view of the above facts and circumstances charges made against him were not proved beyond doubt against the aforementioned student and therefore he was not categorically found guilty of alleged misconduct and indiscipline. The Discipline Committee, therefore took the lenient view in the recommending penalty to be imposed on the student.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on **05.02.2014 (Wednesday) at 03:30 pm.** in the **Pro-Vice-Chancellor** Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) **That Office Memo LD.No.4463/Proc. dated 14.12.2013 is revoked with immediate effect giving benefit of doubt Amir.**
- (b) **That aforementioned student is warned to be more careful in future.**

The afore-mentioned students were subjected to the following disciplinary action vide office Memo 4105/Proc dated 14.11.2013.

- (a) **That the suspension order Office Memo LD No. 3949/Proc. dated 04.11.2013 is revoked with immediate effect.**
- (b) **That Mohd. Umar Farukh, Gulsher Ahmed, Salman Ahmed, Alamgeer and Ashutosh Mishra, Waqas Wasiq Warsi are made NRSC for the current academic session.**
- (c) **That each of them are fined Rs. 2000/- (Two thousand only) to be deposited under the head of the Fine in the Finance & Accounts Department of the University within a week from the date of service of the notice.**
- (d) **That each of them are required to furnish an undertaking in writing within a week to keep good behaviour in future failing which *suo-moto* action shall follow against them.**

Students under reference had moved applications addressed to the Vice-Chancellor pointing out therein that their lives are under threat from some criminals. They further pleaded that they were wrongly held guilty of misconduct vide Office Memo LD. No. 4105/Proc. dated 14.11.2013. They have therefore requested to restore their residential status in view of risk to their life. All the applicants together were called before the Discipline Committee and the Chairman of the Committee explaining the rule position told them that their request being beyond the competence of the Committee is entertained but advised them that they may move a fresh application addressed to the Chairman of the Executive Council/Standing-Cum-Grievance Committee with the request to review the punishment imposed on each of the applicant under clause (b) of Office Memo No. LD.No.4105/Proc. dated 14.11.2013.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on **05.02.2014 (Wednesday)** at **03:30 pm**, in the **Pro-Vice-Chancellor** Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) All the applicants are allowed to move fresh application to the Chairman of the Executive Council/Standing-Cum-Grievance Committee to review the decision imposed under clause (b) of Office Memo No. LD.No.4105/Proc. dated 14.11.2013.**

This has reference to the letter of the Provost, Nadeem Tarin Hall address to the Vice-Chancellor and received in this Office vide R.No.6815/Proc. dated 07.10.2013. It was reported and alleged vide Inquiry report dated 02.10.2013 that aforementioned student along with others within the premises of Nadeem Tarin Hall assaulted Mohd. Nadeem, a student of B.Tech. (III) on 02.10.2013 and thereby created a law and order situation in the Hall.

Taking a note of the complaints, of the Provost the Vice-Chancellor ordered that matter be placed before the Discipline Committee. A notice was sent to aforementioned student vide LD.No.440/Proc. dated 01.02.2014 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on 05.02.2014 (Wednesday) at 03:30 pm in the Office of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor.

Accordingly the matter was listed for hearing before the Committee. Inamur Rehman and complainant were called before the Committee to put up their point of defence. The Provost of the Hall was also there in the meeting to apprise the Discipline Committee with real state of situation. Both the students admitted the alleged happening of incident but the at same time pleaded that it was due to sudden rash and reaction on a silly point and submitted that matter has amicably been settled and are good friend of each other.

In view of the above facts and circumstances it was established that aforementioned student committed acts as provided under the part-II rules-4, (iii), (vii) & (xxiii) of Indiscipline and Misconduct Rules, 1985 but because of retraction of the complainant facilitated to the lenient disciplinary action against the student *supra* and the Discipline Committee took the lenient view in the recommending penalty to be imposed on the student.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on 05.02.2014 (Wednesday) at 03:30 pm. in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) That Inamur Rehman is made N.R.S.C. for the current academic session i.e. 2013-2014 with immediate effect.

The aforementioned students have right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981 within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
