It was alleged vide FIR No. 502, dated 01.07.2013, lodged with Police Station, Civil Lines, Aligarh that a police party led by SHO, Civil Lines, Aligarh in the intervening night of 30.06.2013/01.07.2013 arrested the aforementioned student alongwith six other on the charge of conspiring to commit robbery in house of a Professor in the locality of Sahab Bagh. It was further alleged that aforementioned student and his crime partners in the course of investigation confessed to have committed robbery on 22.09.2012 in the house of Dr. Nafees, Al-Hamd Apartment at Shamshad Market, on-15.04.2013 in the house of Hilal Khursheed, Firdaus Nagar, Aligarh and on 12.06.2013 in the house of Dr. Khalid Sherwani, Sir Syed Nagar, Aligarh. It was also reported and alleged that illegal arms and ammunitions were also recovered from the possession of Mr. Mohd. Asif, the aforementioned student and his accomplices.

In view of the above facts and circumstances it was *prima-facie* established that aforementioned student, Mr. Mohd. Asif alongwith some others committed acts of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (viii), (xiv), (xxii) and (xxiii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo LD. No 2390/Proc. dated 03.07.2013. The Charge Sheet was also issued to him vide LD. No. 2034/Proc. dated 05.06.2014. The reply of the charge sheet was received vide R. No. 3385/Proc dated 07.06.2014. Hence the matter is listed for hearing. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.2055/Proc. dated 07.06.2014 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date, time and venue. At present Mohd. Asif is on bail.


The aforementioned student accordingly appeared before the scheduled Discipline Committee. He was afforded full opportunity to explain his position as to the charges framed against him. He explained the sequence of events leading to his arrest by the Police. He submitted before the Discipline Committee that because of his acquaintance with one of the accused named in the FIR dated 01.07.2013 lodged with Police Station Civil Lines Dohpur, Aligarh, he was falsely implicated in the criminal case. After taking into account facts on record and submission of Mohd. Asif the Discipline Committee was of the view that since he has been enlarged on bail by the Honourable Court and therefore, he may be given opportunity to complete his education i.e. BA LLB (Final Year).

In view of the above facts and circumstances the Committee was of the view that charges framed against Mohd. Asif under Part-II, Rule-4 (viii), (xiv), (xxii) and (xxiii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985 will remain effective till disposal of criminal case.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on 10.06.2014 (Tuesday) at 12:00 Noon in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) That the Office Memo I.D. No. 2390/Proc. Dated 03.07.2013 placing Mohd. Asif under suspension is revoked with immediate effect and his pending result of BA LLB (VIIIth semester) should be declared immediately.
- (b) That Mohd. Asif is debarred from future admission in any course/class in the University and its maintained institutions for next five years after completing his BA LLB course.
- (c) That Mohd. Asif is shifted from Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Hall to NRSC with immediate effect.
- (d) That Mohd. Asif is called upon to furnish an undertaking in writing to maintain good behavior and not to indulge in any activity subversive to law and order within a week from the service of the notice.

The aforementioned student has right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if he is aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.

Asif the Discipline Committee was of the view that since he has been enlarged on bail by the Honourable Court and therefore, he may be given opportunity to complete his education i.e. BA LLB (Final Year).

In view of the above facts and circumstances the Committee was of the view that charges framed against Mohd. Asif under Part-II, Rule-4 (viii), (xiv), (xxii) and (xxiii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985 will remain effective till disposal of criminal case.


