It was reported and alleged vide complaint R.No.1707/Proc. dated 15.03.2014 by Hilal Khan bearing En. No. GC-3265, a student of M.A. (Philosophy) that on 15.03.2014 at 12:00 Noon while he was going from Faculty of Arts, aforementioned student alongwith Ayaz, a student of BSW and some outsiders riding on bike suddenly came towards him and hit his bike from side but he narrowly escaped.

It was further reported that while Hilal Khan was managing to control his bike in the meantime aforementioned student alongwith others stopped and started fighting with him. It was further reported and alleged by Hilal Khan that while he attempted to escape the assault by running away, the aforementioned student opened fire on him with a pistol (country made katta) but he escaped bullet shot. It was also complained that reported incident took place in full public view and security staff posted at Faculty of Arts gate witnessed scene. It was also reported by Hilal Khan that his life is in danger.

In view of the above facts, it was *prima-facie* obvious that aforementioned student committed acts of indiscipline and misconduct under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii), (vii), (xiv) & (xxiii) of AMU Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 1087/Proc. dated 18.03.2014. The Charge Sheet was also issued to him vide LD.No.1203/Proc. dated 26.03.2014. The reply of the charge sheet was received in this office vide R.No.2114/Proc. dated 02.04.2014. Hence the matter was listed for hearing. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No. 1242/Proc. dated 31.03.2014 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time.

The said student accordingly appeared in person before the Discipline Committee held on 03.04.2014 at 05:30 pm in the Office of the Pro Vice-Chancellor. The Committee after deliberation deferred the case of aforementioned student for the next Discipline Committee with the direction that complainant, Hilal Khan bearing En. No. GC-3265, a student of M.A. (Philosophy) should also be called in the next Discipline Committee for clarification. Hence, the case of Md. Zeeshan Khan was listed for hearing before the Discipline Committee held on 10.06.2014 at 12:00 Noon. Notices were sent to Md. Zeeshan Azam and Hilal Khan vide D.No.2053/Proc. & 2054/Proc. dated 07.06.2014 respectively to present themselves before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time. They accordingly presented themselves before the schedule Discipline Committee held 10.06.2014 at 12:00 noon in the office of the Pro Vice-Chancellor.

Md. Zeeshan Azam explaining his position submitted that he did not hit Hilal Khan rather his motorcycle was about to collide but escaped narrowly. He outrightly denied charge of pointing country made pistol (Katta) at Hilal Khan or opening fire in air. He pleaded that he has been implicated out of personal animosity. He admitted the heated discussion with Hilal Khan, he had on the spot.

Hilal Khan explaining sequence of event submitted before the Discipline Committee that Md. Zeeshan Azam was called on telephone by the person who was riding on the bike at the time of accident whereas Md. Zeeshan Azam contradicting this fact said that in fact he was


riding on the bike at the time of alleged incident and was not called by anyone. The oral submission of Hilal Ahmad Khan did not match with his written complaint against Mohd. Zeeshan Azam. The Discipline Committee therefore noted sharp contradiction in the statement of Hilal Khan.

In view of the above facts, circumstances and charges framed against Md. Zeeshan Azam were only partially proved and therefore, he was found guilty of misconduct and indiscipline under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii), (vii), (xiv) & (xxiii) of AMU Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985. The Discipline Committee therefore gave the benefit of doubt to Md. Zeeshan Azam.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on 10.06.2014 (Tuesday) at 12:00 Noon in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor Office has passed the following order:

- (a) Office Memo LD. No. 1087/Proc. Dated 18.03.2014 placing Md. Zeeshan Azam under suspension is revoked with immediate effect.
- (b) Md. Zeeshan Azam is fined Rs. 1000/- (One thousand Only) and same be deposited within a week from the service of the notice in the Finance and Accounts Department, AMU under the head 'Fine' through the Challan form of SBI Bank AMU, Branch and submit a copy of receipt of the fine in the Proctor's Office.
- (c) Md. Zeeshan Azam is required to furnish an undertaking in writing within a week from the service of the notice to maintain good behavior and will not indulge in undesirable activities.
- (d) Md. Zeeshan Azam is strictly warned to be more careful and not to repeat the same in future failing which severe disciplinary action will be taken against him.

The aforementioned student has right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if he is aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
