It was reported and alleged vide complaint R.No.2840/Proc. Dated 23.05.2015 addressed to the Proctor by Mr. Taushif Alam, former Vice-President, AMUSU that on 23.05.2015 at about 05:00 pm he received a call from Shahanshah Khan a student of Ph.D, department of law from the mobile set of Mahtab Alam Khan that he wants to see him and therefore asked his location. It was also reported that when complainant Tauhsif Alam refused to meet him, the aforementioned students alongwith some outsiders after some time reached his room and entered therein holding fire arms, stick, rods etc. It was also complained by Tausif Alam that aforementioned students alongwith their companions picked him at the point of fire arms and thereafter he was taken to M. M. Hall. Further taking him in M.M. Hall, the aforementioned students alongwith others started beating him mercilessly with hockey sticks and butt of Country made pistol. It was also complained that Shanhanshah Khan, aforementioned student opened fire at the complainant with Katta but fortunately fire missed else he would have been killed. It was also complained that due to beating the complainant started vomiting and became unconscious. Therefore, he was immediately shifted to J.N. Medical College Hospital by the Proctorial team for the treatment. It was further reported that aforementioned students alongwith their companions left no stone unturned to kill the complainant.

It is therefore established from the facts mentioned hereinabove that the alleged acts of the above mentioned students amount to misconduct and indiscipline as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii), (vii), (viii) (xiv) & (xxiii) of AMU Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned students were suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 1531/Proc. dated 23/24.05.2015 till the final decision of the competent authority. The University Campus and its maintained institutions were also placed out of bound for them. The Charge Sheets were also issued to them vide LD.Nos.2089, 2090 & 2091/Proc. dated 14.07. 2015. The replies of the charge sheets of Mohd. Shahanshah Khan and Md. Mahtab Khan have been received in this office vide R. Nos. 3874/Proc. and 3901/Proc. dated 20.07.2015 and 21.07.2015 and Abdul Salam Khan reply is yet awaited. Hence the matter was listed for hearing. Notices were sent to the aforementioned students vide D.Nos.2119,2120&2121/Proc. respectively dated 16.07.2015 to present themselves before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time for hearing.

Accordingly, the aforementioned students appeared in person before the Discipline Committee on its meeting held on 23.07.2015 in the Pro Vice-Chancellor's Office at 04:00 pm and the complainant, Taushif Alam was also appeared before the Discipline Committee. The Chairman of the Committee explained allegations levelled against them by the complainant and while following the principle natural justice gave full opportunity to the aforementioned students to prove their innocent from alleged indiscipline and misconduct under Part-II Rule-4 (iii), (vii), (viii), (xiv) & (xxiii) Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The above noted students were examined and cross examined by the members of the Committee on the charges levelled against them but they failed to prove their innocence to the satisfaction of the Discipline Committee, therefore, the D.C. unanimously arrived on the conclusion that aforementioned students are found guilty of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii), (vii), (viii), (xiv) & (xxiii) of Aligarh Muslim University Students' Conduct & Discipline Rules, 1985. In view of the above stated facts, the Discipline Committee took lenient view in consideration of academic records, age and future career and also taking into consideration inquiry report of the alleged incident.


The Vice-Chancellor, therefore on the basis of the recommendation of the Discipline Committee meeting held on 23.07.2015 (Thursday) at 04:00 p.m. in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Office passed the following orders:

**That the suspension Office Memo LD.No.1531/Proc. dated 23/ 24.05.2015 of the aforementioned students is revoked subjected to the following conditions:**

- (a) That aforementioned students must tender unconditional written apology in presence of their fathers separately to the Pro Vice-Chancellor / Proctor, AMU on non-judicial stamp paper assuming good conduct and not to indulge in any misconduct and indiscipline. Proctor shall monitor the activities of the above students.
- (b) Any act of misdemeanour or indiscipline in future will render expulsion from the University.

- (c) That the aforementioned students are shifted from their respective Hall of residence to the N.R.S.C. with immediate effect.
- (d) That on completion of their current course, Md. Mehtab Khan and Abdul Salam Khan be debarred from further admission in any course / class in the University in future.

The aforementioned students have right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if they are aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
