

Applications on prescribed form are invited for **the post of the Two Guest Teachers in Sociology** in the Department of Sociology to teach the postgraduate and undergraduate students of Sociology on payment of fixed emoluments at a rate of Rs. 1000/= per month subject to a maximum of Rs. 25000/= per month. The appointments will be on temporary basis, liable to termination at any time without any notice or assignment of reason.

**Qualifications Essential:**

Good Academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in 7 point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the **Master of Sociology or M.A in Sociology** from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University;

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above, candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor in University/Colleges/Institutions;

**OR**

The candidate having been Ph.D. Degree in Sociology prior to 11.07.2009, the date of notification of UGC (minimum standards procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) & Regulation, 2009 or admitted prior to the aforesaid date and awarded Ph.D. after the above notification and fulfill 6 out of the 11 criteria recommended by the Thyagarajan Committee and have obtained certificate in this regard from the Competent Authority of the Concern University.

NET/SLET/SET shall also not required for such Master's Programme in disciplines for NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**NOTE:**

A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Master's level for the Schedule Caste / Schedule Tribe / Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or on equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above permissible, based on only the qualifying marks with including any grace marks procedures.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. degree holder, who have obtained their Master's degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991.

The last date for the submission of application in the prescribed form in the office of the Department of Sociology is 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 up to 2:00 PM and Interview will be held on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 in the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences at 2:00 PM Incomplete applications and those received after the deadline i.e. 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 up to 2:00 PM will not be entertained. Candidates called for interview will not be paid TA / DA.
