NOTIFICATION DATED 30th JUNE 2011

1. *Whereas*, it was previously notified on 20.05.2011 that *despite of re-scheduling the election dates twice*, the mandatory verification process in accordance to **Statute 43 of the Statutes** of the University was not fulfilled. This was solely because various AMU Alumni (Old Boys) Association failed to provide the mandatory requirements which were requested in earlier notifications.
2. *Whereas*, due to the above, in the notification dated 20.05.2011, the undersigned had sought legal opinion through the University from the Standing Counsel of the University in the Judicature of Allahabad High Court regarding the above.
3. *Whereas*, the University Standing Counsel has opined that instead of waiting for a copy of receipt book from various Old Boys Association in order to verify the voters list furnished by them in accordance to Statute 43 of the University as well as before approaching the Hon'ble High Court, the undersigned may try once more by adopting the following procedure:
 - (a) *Instead of first carrying out verification of voters/members list in accordance to Statute 43, it has been advised as said above to invite nominations directly for the said elections with the condition that the candidates aspiring to contest the said elections should submit a documentary proof along with their nomination papers that they fulfill the mandatory requirements of Statute 43 of the Statutes of the University regarding the said elections.*
 - (b) *All voters must provide documentary proof that they fulfill mandatory requirements of Statute 43 of the University before casting their votes on the day of polling.*
 - (c) *The said documentary proof will include copy of receipt received from the Old Boys Association upon becoming member and a copy of Degree obtained from the University.*
4. *Whereas*, apart from the above, also, **all the contestants** should submit a copy of their ID (i. e. copy of any of the following: Identity Card / Pan Card / Passport / Driving License along with their nomination papers. **The same is required from voters also at the time of polling. Those voters casting their votes through postal ballot will have to send a duly attested copy of their ID proof as well other documents showing that they fulfill the mandatory requirements of Statute 43 of the University.**

5. **Therefore**, in view of the averments depicted above, the final (third) partial re-scheduling of election dates are given below in the tabular form.

6. **Whereas**, the above the final (third) partial re-scheduling of election dates/ election process are strictly subject to fulfillment of the mandatory requirements of Statute 43 of the Statutes of the University by the contestants / voters as said above.

7. **Whereas**, nominations are invited from contestants on plain paper indicating his / her willingness to contest the said election along with the documentary proof regarding information's pertaining to the mandatory requirements in accordance to Statute 43 as said above. It should be addressed to the Chief Election Officer and submitted directly to the office of the undersigned either in person or through speed post / courier or by email at nxi7@hotmail.com or najmul@gmail.com If the contestant is sending his/her nomination application by email, then he/she should send all the relevant documents as said above by scanning the same and emailing it as an attached an file.

8. **Whereas, some mandatory requirements are given below for those voters casting their votes through postal ballot:**

- (a) **They** should post their ballot paper/vote along with certified copy of their above said ID Proof, Copy of Receipt received from the Old Boys Association upon becoming member and a copy of Degree obtained from the University.
- (b) **They** should post the above through speed post/ courier **strictly from the city which is mentioned** in the address provided by respective Old Boys Association in the Voters/Members list, which was long back uploaded on the Official Website (<http://www.amu.ac.in>) of the University by the undersigned under the heading *Old Boys Election in AMU Court 2011*.

(c) **They** should intimate on or before 06.07.2011 directly to the office of the undersigned about any address changes if they have relocated and the same has not been rectified in the voters list by submitting a documentary proof / affidavit of their present address. In order to prevent any postal delay, the same can be sent through email at nxi7@hotmail.com or najmuli@gmail.com as an attached file.

9. **That**, postal ballot/vote **is allowed only for those members** whose residential addresses in the uploaded voters list are of outside Aligarh. Furthermore, Members/Voters residing in Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh **are NOT eligible** for casting their vote **through postal ballot, and instead, they are required to cast their vote in person at the polling booth/center at Aligarh.**

10. **That**, the University / Office of the undersigned will not be responsible in any way for any postal delay.

11. **That**, the venue of polling at Aligarh will be notified shortly.
