URGENT NOTIFICATION DATED 20th MAY 2011

1. *Whereas*, the said election to elect 25 representatives of Ex-students to the University Court under Statute 14(1)(xx) of the Statutes of the University is being carried out on the directives of the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad.
2. *Whereas*, vide reminder dated 21-03.2011, which was displayed on the Official Website of the University as well as also posted through speed post to Hony Gen Secretary of all those Old Boys Associations who had responded to Notifications dated 21.01.2011, 31.01.2011 and 03.02.2011, it was requested to submit the mandatory requirements i. e. copy of receipt book, etc to the undersigned **latest by 25th of March 2011**, and then again, **because of non-compliance of the same**, was again re-extended **latest by 5th of May 2011 vide notification dated 18th April 2011**, so that verification process can be initiated in accordance to Statute 43 of the Statutes of the University.
3. *Whereas*, it was also notified vide **notification dated 18th April 2011 that if the said mandatory requirement was fulfilled latest by 5th of May 2011**, then the remaining process of the said election would take place as mentioned in the column indicating "second re-scheduling of dates" appearing in Table-1 (Kindly see the said Table-1 in the previously published notification dated 18.04.2011).
4. *Whereas*, also, in the above said notification dated 18.04.2011, it was clearly mentioned that "before approaching the Hon'ble High Court in order to apprise the above situation as well as to request for issuing a directive, or any other Order, regarding the said election, **one more last chance is hereby given for submitting the said copy of receipt books, latest by 5th of May 2011, so that verification process can be initiated in accordance to Statute 43 of the Statutes of the University**".
5. *Whereas*, in addition to the above, in the above said notification dated 18.04.2011, it was also notified that "**failing** to submit the above said mandatory requirement or any justifiable suggestions as requested above, latest by 5th of May 2011, **the undersigned will have no other option but to approach the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad for obtaining a directive regarding the said matter.**
6. *Whereas*, this office **has waited much beyond the extended last date** which was **5th of May, 2011**, for receiving the above said mandatory requirement (i.e. copy of receipt book, etc), so that verification process could be initiated in accordance to **Statute 43 of the Statutes** of the University. Unfortunately, because of the above said non-compliance till date, the mandatory verification process in accordance to **Statute 43 of the Statutes** of the University **is still pending.**

7. *Therefore, in view of the above, despite of re-scheduling the election dates twice, the mandatory verification process in accordance to Statute 43 of the Statutes of the University has not been fulfilled, solely because of non-compliance of various AMU Alumni (Old Boys) Association as said above and also indicated in previous notifications.*
8. *Furthermore, because of repeated non-compliance as said above, this office is of the opinion that any further re-extending of dates would probably be a futile attempt, and in turn, would result in further delaying of the said election.*
9. *Hence, in light of the above, the Registrar of the University is being requested to take legal opinion from the University Standing Counsel so that the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad may be approached for obtaining a directive regarding the said matter, so that the elections are not delayed further, because of the non-fulfillment of the above said Statutory requirements of the University regarding the said elections. A detailed chronology of events regarding the above would be submitted shortly for the University Standing Counsel.*
