SUPPLEMENTARY AGENDA

Item 25 To consider the proposal of introduction of M.Sc. (Nematology) course in the Department of Plant Protection.

DECISION

The House noted that the Academic Council in its meeting held on 30.05.2019 had approved that M.Sc. (Ag.) Plant Pathology with revised course structure will be implemented from the session 2018-2019, whereas M.Sc. (Ag.) Nematology in place of M.Sc. (Ag.) Plant Pathology (Specialization : Plant Nematology) will be offered from the session 2019-2020 as M.Sc. (Ag.) Nematology could not be started from the session 2019-2020, it had been **RECOMMENDED** to start the course with existing staff / infrastructure from the forthcoming session 2020-2021 with Intake of 05 seats including 01 seat of ICAR quota. The admission to this course will be made through Departmental Test consisting of one objective type paper of 100 marks comprising a total of 100 questions with 30 questions on General Knowledge, General Awareness in Agricultural Sciences and related branches of Science / Life Science, and 70 questions on Agriculture, Botany, Zoology, Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Chemistry.

Item 26 To consider the recommendations of the BOS of the Dept. of English duly endorsed by the Faculty of Arts in its meeting held on 24.10.2019 regarding modification in Qualifying Examination for admission to M.A. (ELT)

DECISION

RECOMMENDED TO THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL the proposal of the Dept. of English duly approved by the Faculty in its meeting held on 24.10.2019 to modify the Qualifying Examination for admission to M.A. (ELT) Course as follows:

"B.A. / B. Com. / B. Sc. Or equivalent examination with at least 50% marks in aggregate and in English separately".

Item 27 To consider the report of the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to propose the revised syllabus of Indo Islamic Culture for admission test of Class XI / Diploma in Engineering

DECISION

The House **DID NOT AGREE** to the changes proposed in the Syllabus of Indo Islamic Culture for admission test of Class XI / Diploma in Engineering and **RECOMMENDED** to continue with the existing Syllabus.

Any Other Item

DECISIONS

AGREED & RECOMMENDED TO THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL the following:

- The Dean, Faculty of Science apprised that the Board of Studies of the Interdisciplinary Department of Remote Sensing & GIS Application held on 12.12.2019 has recommended modification in the qualification / eligibility for admission to M.Sc. (Remote Sensing & GIS Applications) as follows along with increase in Intake from 15 to 20 seats from the session 2020-2021:

Bachelor's Degree in Geography / Geology / Statistics / Physics / Chemistry / Computer Applications / Mathematics / Botany / Zoology / Forestry / Wildlife / Environmental Science / Civil Engg. / Agricultural or Soil Sciences / Computer Engineering from a recognized University or Institution with not less than 55% marks in aggregate.	Bachelor's Degree in Geography / Geology / Statistics / Physics / Mathematics / Computer Science / Computer Applications / Forestry / Wildlife / Environmental Sciences / Agricultural Sciences and B. Tech. / B.E. in Civil Engg. / Computer Engineering from a UGC recognized University or Institutions with 55% marks in aggregate.

- The House **AUTHORIZED** the Vice-Chancellor to approve the proposed changes subject to endorsement of the same by Faculty.
- The Dean, Faculty of Agricultural Sciences proposed to increase Intake of B.Sc. (Agricultural), being run under Self Financing Mode, from 30 to 40 seats and to reduce the annual Additional Charges (Departmental Development Fee) being charged from the students at the time of admission / start of each academic session from Rs. 60,000/- to Rs. 50,000/-. The House unanimously **RECOMMENDED** the proposal to the Academic Council.
- Prof. Mohammad Gulrez, Dean, Faculty of International Studies proposed to start M.A. in International Studies from the academic session 2020-2021. Similarly, Prof. Qazi Mazhar Ali, Dean, Faculty of Science proposed to introduce M.Sc. Data Analytics course from the session 2020-2021.
The House in principle **AGREED** with both the above proposals and **RECOMMENDED** to authorize the Vice-Chancellor to consider the same subject to concurrence by the Faculty concerned.
- Dr. Mohd. Asif Khan, Coordinator, Centre of Professional Courses raised the issue of introducing a course in Cupping Therapy (Hijmah) in the Department of Ilaj-Bit-Tadbeer under the Centre of Professional Courses. Since, the Academic Council in its meeting held on 03.08.2019 under Any Other Item has already approved in principle to start Certificate course in Cupping Therapy (Hijmah) from the session 2020-2021 and constituted a Committee under the convener ship of Coordinator, CPC to work out eligibility criteria and other details, the House **AUTHORIZED** the Vice-Chancellor to take decision on the recommendation of the said Committee.
