It was reported and alleged vide complaint R.No. Nil dated 07.03.2014 by Faraz Faisal Khan S/o Mohd. Khalid, En. No.GG-4111, a student of XII-PCM that on 7.3.2014 at about 4:30 pm he was going to M.A. Library for study purpose and when he reached near R.M.Hall Pullia, aforementioned students alongwith some other ruffians riding on bikes swiftly moved towards him. It was further reported by Faraz Faisal Khan that noticing aggressive criminal intention of the aforementioned students, he attempted to run away to escape contemplated attack towards the R.M. Hall main gate but afore-noted students opened fire at him with a country made pistol (Katta) intending to kill him. Consequently bullet hit his leg causing excessive bleeding. It was further complained that accomplices of aforementioned students have criminal records in Police Station Civil Lines, Aligarh. An FIR dated 07.03.2014 was lodged with the Police Station Civil Lines, Aligarh.

In view of the above facts, it was *prima-facie* made out that aforementioned students committed acts of indiscipline and misconduct under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii), (vii), (xiv) & (xxiii) of AMU Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned students was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No. 988/Proc. dated 11.03.2014. The Charge Sheets was also issued to the aforementioned students LD.Nos. 1144,1145 & 1146/Proc. dated 20.03.2014 respectively and reply of the charge sheets were received in this office vide R.No.1934/Proc. dated 25.03.2014, R.No.77/SS dated 23.03.2014 and R.No.2107/Proc. dated 02.04.2014. Hence the matter was listed for hearing. A notices were sent to the aforementioned students separately D.Nos.1239,1240 &1241/Proc. dated 31.03.201 to present themselves before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date, time and venue.

The aforementioned students accordingly appeared in person before the Discipline Committee on the scheduled date and time. The Chairman of the Discipline Committee


The aforementioned students accordingly appeared in person before the Discipline Committee on the scheduled date and time. The Chairman of the Discipline Committee complying with the principle of natural justice read over the article of the charges and required the students under reference to explain their positions.

The aforementioned students making the submission before the Committee stated that they were falsely implicated by the complainant whereas they were absolutely innocent. It was further submitted that the complaint dated 07.03.2014 by Faraz Faisal Khan was a fabricated case as opening of the fire was not heard by anyone including Gate Keepers of R.M. Hall which is nearest to the scene of alleged incident.

In view of the above facts and circumstances charges framed against aforementioned students were not proved and therefore they were not found guilty of alleged misconduct and indiscipline by the members of the Committee. Therefore, the Discipline Committee took the lenient view and recommended revocation of their suspension.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on **03.04.2014** (Thursday) at **05:30 pm.** in the **Pro-Vice-Chancellor** Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) That Office Memo LD.No.988/Proc. dated 11.03.2014 placing suspension of aforementioned students is revoked with immediate effect.
- (b) That aforementioned students are allowed to appear in the Re-Sit/supplementary Examinations to clear left over papers by them consequent upon their suspension.
