In the inquiry report the aforementioned student was found guilty of violating Part II, Rule 4 (vii) and (xviii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985. The Vice-Chancellor therefore on the basis of the report of the enquiry had passed the following orders vide Office Memo LD.No.2220/ Proc. dated 12.06.2010.

1. The Maroof Ahmed is fined Rs. 2500/- and be barred from further admission in any course/ class of the Aligarh Muslim University.
2. His results be declared, character and migration certificates be issued to him.

The aforementioned student, Maroof Ahmad has submitted an application to the Vice-Chancellor whereby he has requested for re-consideration of recommendation of Disciplinary Committee followed by order of Vice-Chancellor Communicated to him vide Office Memo No2220/Proc. dated 12.06.2010. Therefore, A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No. 2056/Proc. dated 07.06.2014 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time.

Maroof Ahmad accordingly appeared in person before the Discipline Committee on 10.06.2014. He pleaded that condition debarring him from future admission in any course or class in the University imposed on him vide Office LD. No. 2220/Proc. Dated 12.06.2010 should be withdrawn facilitating him to seek admission in M.Tech. course. The members of the Discipline Committee taking into account the facts on records and submission of Maroof Ahmad arrived on the conclusion that since he has already been issued migration certificate and therefore being no more on the rolls of the University may not be entitled to the relief claimed by him under AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on 10.06.2014 (Tuesday) at 12:00 Noon in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor Office has passed the following order:


- (a) That Office Memo LD. NO. 2220/Proc. dated 12.06.2010 debarring Maroof Ahmad from future admission in any course or class in the University will remain in force for next six academic sessions commencing from 2010-2011.
