Afore-noted students were detained due to shortage of attendance but they appeared in their respective examinations i.e. B.Sc. (II) and B.A. (II) in the academic session 2013-14 with forged Hall Tickets.

The case of afore-noted students, therefore was placed before the Scrutiny Committee in its meeting held on 11.06.2014 and committee concluded that it is an open case of forgery and therefore, they should be subjected to the disciplinary action under Clause 4 (X) Part-II for the acts of indiscipline and misconduct under AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The matter was placed before the Vice-Chancellor for his consideration who was pleased to observe that it was a fit case of disciplinary action as per rules of the University.

Hence, matter was listed before the Discipline Committee for consideration and necessary recommendation. The Notices were sent to the aforementioned students vide D.Nos. 2804 & 2805/Proc. dated 16.08.2014 respectively to present themselves before the Discipline Committee on its scheduled date and time for hearing.

The aforementioned students Ram Krishan Gaur and Khursheed Ahmad Khan accordingly appeared before the scheduled Discipline Committee. The members of the Discipline Committee afforded each one to explain his position as to the charges framed against them. But none of them could give satisfactory reply and from demeanor of Ram Krishan Gaur and Khursheed Ahmad Khan, it was evident beyond the doubt that they obtained Hall ticket by forging the documents. The Discipline Committee therefore was of the considered view that

it is necessary that aforementioned students should be dealt with firmly and no leniency should be shown.

In view of the above facts and circumstances the charges framed against Ram Krishan Gaur and Khursheed Ahmad Khan are established under Clause 4 (X) Part-II for the acts of indiscipline and misconduct under AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985. Therefore, the Discipline Committee recommending the penalty to be imposed on the students.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore, on the basis of the recommendations of the Discipline Committee held on 21.08.2014 (Thursday) at 03:30 pm in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor Office has passed the following orders:

- (a) That Examination results for the session 2013-2014 of Ram Krishan Gaur and Khursheed Ahmad Khan are cancelled.
- (b) That aforementioned students, Ram Krishan Gaur and Khursheed Ahmad Khan are strictly warned to be more careful and not to repeat the same in future failing which severe disciplinary action will follow against them.

The aforementioned students have right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if they are aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
