It was reported and alleged vide complaint dated 14.11.2014 by the Warden of the Mohd. Habib Hall that a boy was lying in the lawn of the Hall. Pursuant to the complaint of the warden a patrolling car of the Proctor office alongwith security guards and a Security Assistant reached immediately on the spot and after search it was found that boy lying in the lawn of the hall was Abhishek a student of Class M.A. (Public Administration). A bottle of vodka, an empty bottle of pepsi and a packet of chips were recovered from his bag and an Identity Card of the University was also found bearing the name and addressed of the aforementioned student. The aforementioned student was immediately sent to J.N. Medical College Hospital for his medical examination and treatment.

The report of medical examination was received in the office of the Proctor vide R.No.6955/Proc. dated 15.11.2014 and it was confirmed from the medical report that aforementioned student was drunk.

It was therefore established from the facts mentioned hereinabove that the alleged acts of the above mentioned student amounted to misconducts and indiscipline as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (iii) & (xii) of AMU Students Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

Therefore, the aforementioned student was suspended vide Office Memo LD.No.3840 (A)/Proc. dated 20.11.2014 from the rolls of the University and the University Campus and its maintained institutions were placed out of bound for him. The charge sheet was sent to the student vide LD.No.4165/Proc. dated 22.12.2014. The reply of the charge sheet was received on 16.02.2015 R.No. 858/Proc. in this Office. Notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.515/Proc. dated 13.02.2015 to be present before the Discipline Committee on its scheduled date and time to clarify his position.

The noticee did not appear before the Discipline Committee but he submitted an application whereby he confessed alleged misconducts and also apologized to the University authorities. He also assured vide his application not to repeat same in future.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, it was established that Abhishek is guilty of misconducts and indiscipline as provided under Part-II Rule 4 (iii) & (xii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985, but the members of the Discipline Committee were of the view that he deserves to be dealt with leniency and may therefore be given a chance to improve himself.

Therefore, on the recommendation of the Discipline Committee held on 16.02.2015 at 03:30 pm. in the Pro Vice-Chancellor Office, the Vice-Chancellor has passed the following orders.

- (a) That the suspension order Office Memo LD No.3840(A)/Proc. dated 20.11.2014 is revoked with immediate effect.
- (b) That aforementioned student should be fined Rs. 2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) to be deposited under the head of the 'Fine' in the Canara Bank AMU Branch through challan form within a week from the date of service of the notice and submit a copy of the receipt of the same in the Office of the Proctor.
- (c) That above-noted student should be warned and be required to furnish an undertaking to maintain good conduct in future, within a week from the date of service of the notice and submit the same in the Office of the Proctor, failing which *suo-moto* action may follow against him.

The aforementioned student has right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if he is aggrieved from the aforementioned decision within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
