It was reported and alleged vide complaint R.No.2419/Proc. 02.05.2015 by Professor Mrs. Samina Khan, Department of English, AMU, Aligarh that on 30.04.2015 at about 07:00 pm an unknown boy about 25 years of age trespassed in her house, B-25, Gulistan Housing Complex, Face-B Anoopshahar Road, Aligarh. Noticing unauthorized entry of the boy, the complainant and her family members stopped him just to know who is he. The boy thereupon attempted to escape but the husband of the complainant grabbed him and asked his name and address. It was also complained that the suspected boy instead of disclosing his identity indulged in squabble and fighting and also threatened him of dire consequences. Hearing the hue and cry, reportedly, the neighbours of the complainant rushed to the scene and helped in holding on the boy and immediately the matter was reported to the police. It was further reported that taking cognizance of the report, the boy was taken into the custody by the police alongwith his motorcycle for further interrogation and investigation. In the course of preliminary investigation, the suspected boy disclosed his name as Tapan Singh S/O. Mr. Anurag Singh resident of D-7 Mansarovar Colony Ramghat Road, Aligarh. He further disclosed that he is a bonafide student of BA LLB in the Faculty of Law, AMU, Aligarh. It was also reported that at the time of incident the aforementioned student was drunk.

Therefore, in view of the above stated facts, it was *prima-facie* established that aforementioned student has committed the acts of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (iv), (vii) (xii), (xvi) (xxiii) & (xxvii) of AMU Student' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 1316/Proc. dated 05.05.2015 pending Enquiry. The University Campus and its maintained institutions were also placed out of bound for him. The Charge Sheet was also issued to him vide LD. No. 2088/Proc. dated 14.07. 2015. The reply of the charge sheet has been received in this office vide R. No. 3847/Proc. dated 16.07.2015. Hence the matter was listed for hearing. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.2118/Proc. dated 16.07.2015 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time for hearing.

Accordingly, Tapan Singh appeared before the Discipline Committee held on 23.07.2015 at 04:00 pm in the Pro Vice-Chancellor Office and the complainant, Prof. Samina Khan, Department of English also appeared before the Discipline Committee. The Chairman of the Discipline Committee gave full opportunity to Tapan Singh with principle of the justice to defend the charges levelled against him.

The above noted student was examined and cross examined by the members of the Committee on the charges levelled against him and the complainant, Prof. Samina Khan was also given opportunity to give justification related to the complaint lodged by her against the aforementioned student by the members of the Discipline Committee. The above noted student failed to prove his innocence to the satisfaction of the Discipline Committee, therefore, the D.C. unanimously arrived on the conclusion that aforementioned student is guilty of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule 4 (iv), (vii), (xii), (xvi) (xxiii) & (xxvii) of Aligarh Muslim University Students' Conduct & Discipline Rules, 1985. During the course of investigation by the Discipline Committee on 23.07.2015, Tapan Singh, the aforementioned student and his mother submitted an apology before the Discipline Committee that after the completion of his course he will not apply for any further study/course in the University in future. In view of the above facts, the members of Discipline Committee took lenient view in consideration of academic records, age and future career and mercy appeal of his mother.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore on the basis of the recommendation of the Discipline Committee meeting held on 23.07.2015 (Thursday) at 04:00 p.m. in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Office passed the following orders:

That the suspension Office Memo LD.No.1316/Proc. dated 05.05.2015 of the aforementioned student, Tapan Singh is revoked with the following conditions:

- (a) That aforementioned student is warned to be more careful in future and furnish an undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper to maintain good conduct & discipline in future.
- (b) He is allowed to appear in the Re-sit examination of his course i.e. BA LLB (Final Year) as and when examination is conduct by the University.
- (c) The aforementioned student is debarred from further admission in any course/class in the University in future.

The aforementioned student has right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if he is aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
