It was reported and alleged vide complaint R.No.1963/Proc. dated 11.04.2015 by the Office bearers of AMU Students' Union Aligarh that on 11.04.2015, the AMU Students' Union had organized a reception program to honour Mr. K.C. Tyagi (M.P.) who is also member of AMU Court. It has further been alleged that as the guest Mr. Tyagi reached the Union Hall, the aforementioned student alongwith 20 people also reached the Union Hall and opened fire in front of the University guest. It was also complained that when some students present over there tried to prevent them, the aforementioned student alongwith his henchmen engaged in scuffles with them and further opened four rounds of fire shots while the guest Mr. K.C. Tyagi was sitting inside the Union Hall.

This show of criminal force allegedly not only upset the guest, who consequently cancelled his further programs in the University, but also put the students including Office bearers of the AMU Students' Union and guest Mr. K. C. Tyagi himself in grave danger of grievous injury. The intention of aforementioned student allegedly appeared as if he alongwith his men had come to seriously assault or kill the Office bearer (s) of AMU, Student Union present in the Union Hall.

Therefore, in view of the above stated facts, it is *prima-facie* established that aforementioned student committed the acts of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (i), (ii), (vii) (xiv), (xxiii) & (xxvii) of AMU Student' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 1106/Proc. dated 13.04.2015 pending enquiry. The Charge Sheet was also served to him vide LD. No. 2087/Proc. dated 14.07. 2015. The reply of the charge sheet has been received in this office vide R. No. 3825/Proc. dated 16.07.2015. Hence the matter was listed for hearing. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.2117/Proc. dated 16.07.2015 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time for hearing.

Mohd. Zoraiz accordingly appeared before the Discipline Committee. The complainant, Abdullah Azzam, Ex-President, AMU, Student's Union also appeared in person before the Discipline Committee held on 23.07.2015 and explained his grieves but other two complainants Syed Masoodul Hasan, Ex-Vice-President, AMU, Student's Union and Shahzeb Ahmad, Ex-Hony. Secretary, AMU, Student's Union did not appear before the Discipline Committee despite the notices were served upon them to be present before the Discipline Committee. The inquiry report submitted by the Inquiry Committee dated 09.05.2015 revealed that there is no supportive evidence of any eye witness nature to the incident at the Union Hall other than the complainants, thus, it is not possible to establish the responsibility, fix the culpability of the alleged gunshot firing on any individual of the facts.

Further, the above noted student was examined and cross examined by the members of the Committee on the charges levelled against him but he could not satisfy the members of the Discipline Committee and failed to prove his innocence to the satisfaction of the Discipline Committee. Therefore, the D.C. unanimously arrived at the conclusion that the aforementioned student is guilty of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule-4 (i), (iii), (vii) (xiv), (xxiii) & (xxvii) of Aligarh Muslim University Students' Conduct & Discipline Rules, 1985. However, the Inquiry Committee keeping in view the above stated facts took the lenient view and while considering the academic record, age and future career of the student:

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore on the basis of the recommendation of the Discipline Committee meeting held on 23.07.2015 (Thursday) at 04:00 p.m. in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Office passed the following orders:

That the suspension Office Memo LD.No.1106/Proc. dated 13.04.2015 of the aforementioned student, Mohd. Zoraiz is revoked on fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (a) That aforementioned student should tender a written apology in the presence of his father to the Pro Vice-Chancellor/Proctor, AMU on non-judicial stamp paper to maintain good conduct and not to associate with any criminal group. Proctor will watch particularly his activities in future.
- (b) Repetition of any act of indiscipline in future shall result in his expulsion from the University rolls.
- (c) That he is shifted from Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Hall to N.R.S.C with immediate effect.

The aforementioned student has right to appeal before the Executive Council (referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, if he is aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from the date of the service of this Office Memo.
