It was reported by the Provost, Aftab Hall vide complaint R. No. 540/SS/Proc. dated 31.05.2015 addressed to the SHO, Civil Lines, Aligarh that in the intervening night of 30/31.05.2015 at about 1:30 a.m., Vice-Chancellor alongwith the Registrar, DSW, then Proctor, City Magistrate, ADM (City), S.P. (City), C.O (City) and other police officials raided Annexe Morison Court, Aftab Hall. In the course of search of the rooms of the Annexe four cartridges of 12 bore were recovered. It was also reported by the Provost that in the Annexe under reference, aforementioned student was residing.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, it was *prima-facie* established that aforementioned student has committed acts of indiscipline and misconduct as provided under Part-II, Rule 4 (xiv), (xxiii) & (xxviii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985.

The aforementioned student was suspended from the rolls of the University vide Office Memo No 1607/Proc. dated 01.06.2015 till the final decision of the competent authority. The university Campus and its maintained institutions were also placed out of bound for him. The Charge Sheet was also issued to him vide LD.No. 2092/Proc. dated 14 .07. 2015. The reply of the charge sheet has been received in this office vide R. No.3878/Proc. dated 21.07.2015. Hence the matter was listed for hearing. A notice was sent to the aforementioned student vide D.No.2122/Proc. dated 16.07.2015 to present himself before the Discipline Committee on its schedule date and time for hearing.


The aforementioned student Taushif Alam accordingly appeared before the scheduled Discipline Committee. The members of the Discipline Committee afforded him to explain his position as to the charges framed against him. He could not give satisfactory reply and admitted his guilt and ensured the Committee not to indulge in such activities in future. The Discipline Committee therefore was of the considered view that aforementioned student is guilty of indiscipline and misconduct acts as provided under Part-II, Rule 4 (xiv), (xxiii) & (xxviii) of AMU Students' Conduct and Discipline Rules, 1985. The Discipline Committee keeping in view the above stated facts and took lenient view in consideration of academic records and his future career.

The Vice-Chancellor, therefore on the basis of the recommendation of the Discipline Committee meeting held on 23.07.2015 (Thursday) at 04:00 p.m. in the Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Office passed the following orders:

That the suspension Office Memo LD.No.1607/Proc. dated 01.06.2015 of the
aforementioned student is revoked with the following conditions:

- (a) That the aforementioned student must tender an apology in presence of his
father / mother to the Pro Vice-Chancellor / Proctor, AMU on non-judicial
stamp paper to maintain good conduct and not to indulge in any
misconducts and indiscipline during the course of his stay in the
university.
- (b) That the aforementioned is shifted from Aftab Hall to the N.R.S.C. with
immediate effect.
- (c) That the aforementioned student is debarred from further admission in any
course/class in the University in future.

The aforementioned student has right to appeal before the Executive Council
(referred hereinafter as EC) under Section 36 (B) of Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment)
Act, 1981, if he is aggrieved from the aforementioned decisions within three months from
the date of the service of this Office Memo.
