### **General facilities**

1. Wi-Fi facility has been employed in the Academic Block for faculty members and Administrative Block for usage of the Office of the Director along with internet facilities at computer lab for students.
2. Photocopying and printing facility has been provided in the library and office for faculty members.
3. Generator facility has been provided in the Academic Block to ensure uninterrupted power supply during examinations or presentations etc.
4. Water coolers have been employed in the Academic Block for usage of faculty and non-teaching staffs.

### **Warden Report (Boys' Hostel)**

1. For day-to-day activities related to hostel matters, adequate supporting staff (Guard, maintenance staff such as electrician, sweeper) are readily available.
2. Hostels have the 40 rooms in which 18 rooms are double seated and rest rooms are four seated. 80 students have been accommodated from both courses, MBA and B.Ed in the Hostels. Only two rooms are vacant.
3. An anti-ragging committee has been constituted by the Director, AMU Kishanganj Centre to ensure that no ragging takes place in the hostel and maintain a ragging free Hostel.
4. A Disciplinary committee has been constituted by the Director, AMU Kishanganj Centre to ensure maintenance of discipline in and around the Hostels.
5. Net has been fitted on every window of the hostel to control the insects which can harm the students.
6. Plumbing work has been done to ensure the smooth functioning of the toilets, tap water, and wash basins in the hostel.
7. Replacement of damaged doors with new doors and repair of remaining doors and walls has been done.
8. A reading room, mosque and a common room have been provided for the students in the hostel.
9. AquaGuard Machine has been setup to provide pure water to the students of the hostel
10. Geyser facility has been provided in the hostel on two floors to provide hot water in the winter season.

### **Warden Report (Girls' Hostel)**

1. Total number of inmates: 36

3. Facilities in the room include separate bed for each hosteller, switch board and one table, mirror and wall almirah.
4. Common facilities include kitchen with LPG cylinder; refrigerator; washing machine; inverter; water purifier(RO); geyser; common room and reading room.

### **NCTE Update:**

NCTE team visited the Aligarh Muslim University Centre Kishanganj on 09.03.2016 to inspect and verify the infrastructural and instructional facilities provided by the Aligarh Muslim University Centre Kishanganj and also the essential documents as per NCTE Regulations.

ERC in its 210th Meeting held on 7th-9th April 2016 after considering the documents submitted by the Aligarh Muslim University Centre Kishanganj as per the provisions of NCTE Act 1993

decided to issue a show-cause notice to Aligarh Muslim University Centre Kishanganj vide No.46980 Dated: 03.06.2016 on the following:

(i) CD is not in function mode. The university is required to submit a fresh CD indicating whole area of the teacher education department.

(ii) Building plan and building completion certificate indicating the demarcated land and building for proposed B.Ed. course duly approved by Government/University Engineer.
