CONTENTS OF THE WORKSHOP

Intellectual Property Rights in an Academic Institute

During initial research setup amidst other ongoing challenges, we generally overlook our own IP, which at times, results into less than expected growth in the R&D log. Can (and should) we do anything to change things? The panel will discuss different types of IPs, relevance of IP in a R&D Institute, and IP as a robust business tool.

Patent Filing Procedures: Domestic and Overseas

It is noteworthy that 60% of the patent applications are rejected as they fail to meet basic procedural requirements which include poor drafting of specification and claim, improper management of deadlines, and non substantiated communication with patent agents and patent offices. Can (and should) we do anything to change things? The panel will discuss about the procedures of disclosing, drafting, reading, and filing.

Understanding the R&D workflow and possibility to incorporate IPR Policy within an organization and their benefits

R&D in itself is rigorous exercise involving a number of stages, which includes conceptualization, Experimentation / study, analysis of the outcomes and most of the time ends in a publication. Slight moderation of the traditional flow of work and incorporation of IP as a concept can result into commercially successful innovations. The panel will discuss importance of patent protection over publication.

Ignorance or even lack of awareness is never an excuse in Legal & IPR domains. To be in the competition, it is always required to be more aware and more knowledgeable. The panel will discuss various issues relating to IPR with participants and share mutual experience and knowledge in related field.

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
