The Participants will be paid AC 2 tier rail fare or AC bus Fare by shortest route, subject to production of original fare tickets. The boarding and Lodging will be arranged by the department as per rule. Candidates are also required to bring the photocopy of the registration certificate of respective states.

Important Instructions to the Applicants:

- 1. The Number of trainees in each program will be 30.
- 2. The Trainee is allowed to attend a maximum of two programs (CME) in a year.
- 3. Aadhar details (in the form of soft copy) should be submitted along with the duly filled registration form.
- 4. No amount would be paid to the trainees except the reimbursement of travelling expenses. The payment will be made only on the production of original tickets by trainees/ resource persons.
- 5. The payment should be made as per CME guidelines or rate of tickets whichever is less.
- 6. In case of air fares (allowed only by economy class apex tickets of Air India/ Indian Airlines) the head of the institution would ensure the actual travel by the person and photocopy along with the boarding pass will be collected and in case of e-tickets before re-imbursement and attach with TA bills. The tickets can be purchased only through Air India Website/ Counter/ IRCTC/ Ashoka Travels/ Balmer & Lawrie. No re-imbursement will be given if ticket is purchased from any other website (such as Yatra.com, Paytm etc.)
- 7. For return journey, the same amount will be reimbursed for the same class/mode as claimed by the claimant.
- 8. Road mileage will be considered only for the places not connected by rail. With regards to road mileage, actual rate but not exceeding approved rate under TA rules. Claimant should mention distance between the places.
- 9. Places where connected by rail, the road mileage is limited to 2AC rail charges or actual claim, whichever is less.
- 10. Local trainees will be paid Rs 500/- per program towards local TA only once for To & Fro.
- 11. Applicants are eligible for food expenses if travels made by train/ bus production of bills subject to a maximum of Rs 175/- during journey. No food expenses are paid for travel made by Rajdhani/ Shatabdi/ Duranto trains and air tickets.
- 12. Boarding and Lodging charges (Maximum 6 days) Rs 1800/- per day per trainees for outstation trainees and Rs. 250/- per day per trainee for local trainees will be applicable.
