The Centre for Women's Studies, Aligarh Muslim University in collaboration with the Indian Council of Social Science Research, New Delhi is going to organize a National Seminar on the theme "Women of Marginalised Communities: Concerns about Exclusion" from November 14th-16th, 2018.

Women as a category have been historically marginalized because of the patriarchal framework of society. They are denied their basic rights and face discrimination in all spheres of life. However, the problems of women belonging to marginalized communities gets further complicated as their issues are an amalgamation of many levels of subordination. There can be several strategies for mainstreaming women of marginalized communities. This includes focusing on women's education, health, livelihood or dealing with issues of Gender based violence etc. At the academic level, a seminar to explore the complex concerns of the women of marginalized communities in India, can provide a significant platform where social scientists and researchers can share their views on the issue. The present seminar intends to identify crucial factors regarding issues of women of marginalized communities and provide important suggestions for policy making.

The following sub themes can be broadly discussed during the discussion:

#### **Subthemes:**

- Women of Ethnic Minorities, Minority Religions, North East, Jammu and Kashmir
- Dalit Women and issues of Class, Caste and Race
- Women of Marginalized communities and Access to Education and Health
- Women's Movement and Women of Marginalized communities
- Politics and Women Leaders from Marginalized Communities
- Women of Marginalized communities and Gender based Violence
- Women of Marginalized communities in Media and Literature
- Strategies for Empowerment of Women of Marginalized communities
- Evaluation of laws and State Policies for Women of Marginalized communities

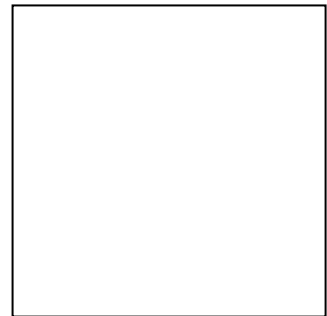
