## **About the Workshop**

Capacity building is a process of enrichment of young faculty members and scholars with new concepts, ideas, technology and paradigms through organized lectures of senior experts in different concerned disciplines as well as through participatory and interaction methods in a workshop. Capacity building programme is very common means to develop the concerned personalities with changing ideas in political, religious, business as well as social organizations. Group participation, field survey as well as project writing techniques would be also operated in this program.

## **The Aligarh Muslim University**

Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) is a public university, funded by the central Government of India. It was established by Sir Syed Ahmad Khan as Madrasatul Uloom Musalmanan-e-Hind in 1875, which later became Mohammedan Anglo-Oriental College (MAO College). The Mohammedan Anglo-Oriental College became Aligarh Muslim University in 1920. The main campus of AMU is located in the city of Aligarh in Western Uttar Pradesh in North India. There are three fully functioning off-campus centers located in the cities of Malappuram (Kerala), Murshidabad (West Bengal) and Kishanganj (Bihar). In 2014, the University ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> among the Indian universities by Times Higher Education, Asia Rankings 2014.

## **The Department of Geography**

The Department of Geography, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh was established in 1924 which is the oldest department of Geography in the Indian sub-continent. Since then the department is imparting geographical knowledge at under-graduate, post-graduate level and pursuing research in almost all the fields of Geography, especially in Agriculture, Rural-Urban Development, Population, Environment and Planning. The thrust area of the Department is in the field of Agriculture, Environment and Population Geography as identified by the UGC as SAP-DRS-III for extending the frontiers of geographical knowledge in teaching and research innovations.

## **The Aligarh City**

Aligarh is notable for being the seat of Aligarh Muslim University. The city is nicknamed *Tala Nagri*, "The City of Locks" for its famous Lock industry. Aligarh is located approximately 90 miles (140 km) south-east of the capital city of New Delhi and 85 km from Agra. It is very well connected with major cities of India by railways and roads. Weather in Aligarh becomes warm and dry by the end of March and temperature ranges between 21°C and 35°C.

**Selection Criteria:**

Young faculties from different disciplines of social science, commerce, management and International Studies are applicable to participate in workshop.

**How to Apply:**

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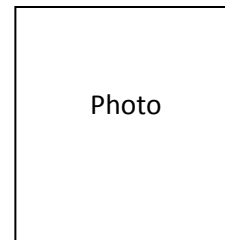
