Applications are invited on the prescribed form for the following post **in the Department of Law at AMU Malappuram Centre, (Kerala)** on contractual basis as per University rules. The appointment will be purely temporary till the end of Academic Session 2019-20 or till the vacancy is filled up through General Selection Committee (GSC) whichever is earlier and liable to termination at any time without any notice or assignment of reason:

**Assistant Professor in Law (Contractual) - 01 Post**

**Essential Qualifications: Eligibility (A or B)**

**A**

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned / relevant / allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be, are exempted from NET/SLET/SET: Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET / SLET / SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in the University subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: -
  - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
  - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
  - c) An open Ph.D. viva-voce of the candidate has been conducted;
  - d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
  - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in Conference / Seminars sponsored / funded/ supported by the UGC/ ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of above conditions is to be certified by the Registrar/ Controller of Examinations of the University.

**Note:** NET/SLET/SET shall also not be a requirement for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
