Applications on prescribed form are invited for the appointment of one Guest Teacher for PG Diploma in Pest Management being run in the Department of Plant Protection under Centre of Professional Courses, AMU, Aligarh on payment terms, as per University rules for the session 2018-19. The appointment will be made on purely temporary basis liable to termination at any time without notice or assigning reason.

Qualifications:

- i. Good Academic record as defined by the University with atleast 55% marks (or an equivalent grade wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's and Doctorate Degree in Plant Protection, Plant Pathology, Entomology or related field.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR etc.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (i) and (ii) above candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor of equivalent position in Universities/ Colleges/ Institution.


Note:

- (i) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace marks procedures.
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holder, who have obtained their Master's degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- (iii) Preference shall be given to the candidates having adequate knowledge and experience in both Plant Pathology and Entomology.

Applications (hard copy) duly filled along with a Demand Draft of Rs.300/- in favour of Finance Officer, AMU payable at Aligarh or the original cash receipt deposited at AMU Cash Counter should be submitted in the office of the Chairperson by 15.11.2018 (Upto 4.0 PM). The interview will be held on 17.11.2018 at 12.15 PM in the Chamber of the Dean, Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, AMU, Aligarh. Applicants may please communicate their e-mail ID and contact number along with the application.

A separate interview letter will not be issued, and candidates will not be paid TA/DA to attend the interview.
