Applications on the prescribed form are invited for the appointment of the **GUEST FACULTY (LINGUISTIC) ONE POST** in the Women's College, AMU Aligarh on payment of fixed emoluments not less than the monthly gross salary of a regularly appointed Assistant Professor. The appointment will be on temporary basis, liable to termination at any time without any notice or assignment of reason:

### Essential Qualifications:

- i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university;
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET;
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above, candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor of equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions;

OR

The Candidates awarded Ph.D. Degree prior to 11.07.2009, the date of notification UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulation 2009 or admitted prior to the aforesaid date and awarded Ph.D. degree after the above notification shall also be eligible to apply for the post of Assistant Professor/Guest Faculty provided they fulfill minimum 6 out of 11 Criteria recommended by the Thyagrajan Committee and produce a Certificate to this effect issued by the office of the Controller of Examination.

- iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programs in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

### Note:

1. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991.
