Dear students,

You might be aware that there is a demand from some students to hold Aligarh Muslim University Students Union (AMUSU) elections. I want to assure you that the university is committed to respecting the democratic rights of students.

At the moment, however, there are some constraints in holding elections as the admission process for Ph.D. courses is not complete yet. If the new Ph.D. students are denied a choice to exercise their voting rights in the elections, the whole exercise will be rendered faulty. I write this letter in the hope that the current students will step into the shoes of students who are seeking admission into AMU this year and understand that it is important to protect their rights.

In this regard, I called a meeting of the Deans of faculties, Registrar, Controller of Examination, Proctor, Aligarh Muslim University Students Union (AMUSU) Treasurer and other senior officers and teachers to discuss the demand for conducting AMUSU elections in which it was decided to consider the matter after the Ph.D. admissions are completed.

I would also like the students to fully understand that it is imperative to maintain proper academic atmosphere for the Mid-Term examination scheduled from September 25 and to participate in Sir Syed Bicentenary celebrations with enthusiasm and pride. This is possible only when there is peaceful atmosphere on the campus.
