IMPORTANT NOTICE

As per terms of Office Memo No. 185/Reg dated September 23, 2017, the University notified the appointment of Chief Election Officer (CEO) on October 30, 2017. The Core Committee constituted to recommend a date for conducting the AMUSU election / student representatives to AMU Court met on November 01, 2017 at 11:00 AM and after detailed deliberations with the Controller of Exams, Proctor and DSW recommended to hold the AMUSU elections either on 13th or 15th November 2017 as per commitment made by the University Administration. Further the house authorized the Proctor and CEO to take the requisite input from the district administration before finalizing the date of election. The Proctor apprised the house of the unstinted and unqualified support being provided by the District Administration to the University.

The Proctor & CEO subsequently met the District Officials in the evening of November 01, 2017 at 06:00 PM on the matter. The District Officials informed them that in view of the ongoing Municipal Corporation Elections in the entire district scheduled for November 26, 2017, no police support can be provided to the University till December 02, 2017 (day of counting). They further advised the University officials that two elections should not be held simultaneously and suggested that the AMUSU Elections may be scheduled after December 03, 2017.

The above matter was discussed in detail in the meeting of Deans, Principals of Colleges, local members of the Executive Council and other functionaries in the Committee Room, Administrative Block on November 02, 2017 at 9:00 AM. Considering the recommendations of Core Committee and the suggestions of the District Administration it was unanimously resolved that:-

1. The University is committed to holding the AMUSU elections at the earliest.
2. The election to AMUSU may be notified from November 28 to December 09, 2017.
3. The Controller of Exams in consultation with the Dean of Faculties may modify the academic calendar and examination schedule accordingly.
4. The students be advised to maintain proper decorum and they should not try to disrupt the classes and other academic activities.

This is being issued with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
